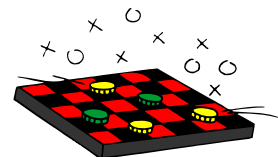

Grundtvig Trip to Portugal – May 2011

As part of the Grundtvig funding, me, Mike Harrington, Clive Rhodes, Janette Fisher and Nick Robinson went on a 4 day trip to Pavao de Varzim in Portugal to visit other Social Enterprise Projects like Heathlands.

Along with people from Romania and Slovakia we visited projects around the area to see how they worked and share ideas. I got a lot out of the visit, like learning about other people cultures and how people with learning disabilities live in other countries.

One of the places we went to was a women's refuge for women with alcohol problems which is not recognised as an illness in Portugal because of their drinking culture.

We also went to a day care centre, where they look after a wide age range of people, from babies to the elderly.

We then went to a centre for homeless children and I found this overwhelming as we looked around their bedrooms.

While we were in Portugal we tried lots of different food and drink and met some lovely people.

There is a trip planned to Romania this year to see their project.
